

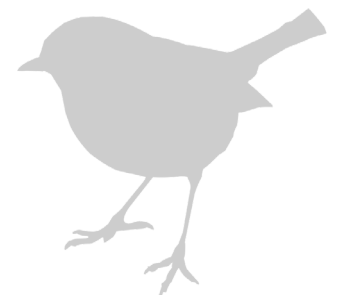
## Osoyoos Oxbows Bird List
