When visiting one of our properties, please keep these guidelines in mind out of respect for others and for your safety:

RESPECT NATURE & OTHERS

Before hitting the trail, check signage at trailheads to ensure your visit supports nature and NCC's commitment to caring for our nature reserves.

TAKE ONLY PICTURES, KEEP ONLY MEMORIES

Leave flowers, plants, rocks and twigs behind for the enjoyment of others and for the integrity of the local ecosystem.

LEAVE NO TRACE

Stay on marked trails, and pack out what you pack in.

PARK SAFELY

Please park with care. If parking on the roadside, park where your car is easily visible and doesn't obstruct any public or private access routes. If designated parking areas are full, please choose another area hike to reduce over-use.

FIRES ARE PROHIBITED

Camping and campfires are not permitted on any NCC properties.

KEEP PETS ON LEASH

Where dogs are permitted on NCC lands, they must be kept on a leash.

Clean up and remove any and all dog waste.
